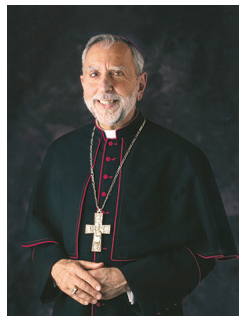


# Bethlehem University and the Diocese of Tucson

## Endowed Scholarships:

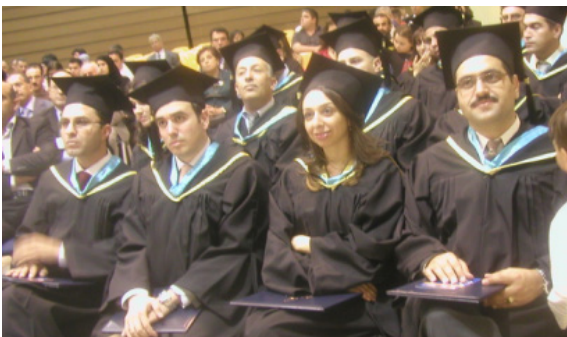
