Let us ask God to bless each and every one of them this school year.





SHOW UP FOR MARY...Mark your calendars for the weekend of October 27, 2024, the feast of Our Lady Queen of Palestine. This year, as Knights and Dames of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem, we encourage you to show your devotion to Our Lady Queen of Palestine, our Patron Saint, and to increase parishioners' awareness of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem.

We are inviting parishioners throughout the Archdiocese of Las Vegas to participate in a special Rosary 30-minutes prior to the start of Masses on the weekend of October 26/27, 2024. The purpose of this Rosary is to showcase devotion to Our Lady Queen of Palestine and implore her intersession for peace in the Holy Land, particularly significant as the one-year anniversary of the violence that occurred on October 7, 2023, and continues today.

Bulletin announcements are being provided to parishes with an invitation to "SHOW UP FOR MARY" with information and links to videos, including one featuring Bishop Gordon explaining the Equestrian Order and the significance of Our Lady Queen of Palestine to the Equestrian Order.

On the weekend of October 26/27, we encourage all Knights and Dames to attend a Rosary at their home parish, 30-minutes prior to the Mass, dressed in ceremonial robes. Robed and reverent, the participation of the Order will signify the immense devotion we have for Our Lady Queen of Palestine. From our experience, we have witnessed great interest and curiosity in the EOHSJ when people see our Knights and Dames in their robes. Following the Masses, in the narthex or courtyard, Knights and Dames will be available to greet or answer questions about the Order very informally. When explaining the Order to curious parishioners, focus on the following: the EOHSJ is the only institution of the Vatican State charged with providing for the needs of the Latin Patriarchate and for providing support of a Christian presence in the Holy Land. We are a Papal Order. Further, Knights and Dames are called to support each other in our individual quest for personal sanctification. Be sure to verify your parish is participating in the Rosary before you attend in your robe.

We and a handful of Knights and Dames are in the continual process of informing Pastors of the feast day Rosary. If you would like to join in this effort by just approaching your Pastor, please let us know.



JUSTICE & PEACE... AN UPDATE ON LIFE IN THE WEST BANK...In a typical year 1.5 million tourists visit the city of Bethlehem. Now, it's a ghost town where average citizens struggle to earn a day's pay. Cabdrivers barely bring in enough money for a pack of cigarettes.

Since October 7th, Israel has instituted 700 new movement restrictions in the West Bank. Barricades and new checkpoints lengthen travel times, prevent people from going to work, and block access to stores they used to frequent. At most, kids go to school two days a week.

National Security Minister Itamar Ben Gvir stated, "The right to life for Jewish residents in the West Bank is more important than the freedom of movement for residents of the Palestinian Authority. I expect that there will be more and more checkpoints, that there will be restrictions. Our enemies do not look for excuses, our enemies just want to harm us."

MEMBER ENGAGEMENT..." SYMPATHY" & "PRAYING FOR YOU" CARDS SUB-COMMITTEE



MEMBER SPOTLIGHT ...Knights and Dames, it is my pleasure to spotlight Knight Chaplain Fr. Daniel Rolland of the Order of Preachers, also known as the Dominicans.




Fr. Daniel is the Director of the Newman Center, a fully functioning Church with daily Mass, Confessions, Bible study, music ministry, spiritual direction, etc. on the campus of University of Nevada Las Vegas. During his nine years as Director, he has led the students and the surrounding community in creating a prayerful presence on campus, particularly by commissioning a jewel box of an Adoration Chapel, which I love to visit. Fr. Daniel and the Newman Center also host a Medieval Feast every January to celebrate St. Thomas Aquinas with feasting, festive performances and a crowned King and Queen chosen from the larger Catholic community. In a beautiful symmetry some of our Knights and Dames have been crowned Kings and Queens of the Feast in the past.

Fr. Daniel has also brought staged play readings (one directed by yours truly), haunted houses, game nights and barbeques to the students – giving them a home away from home as they grow in Catholicism. In the 9 years that I've known Fr. Daniel, I know of a conversion story per year where a student has essentially wandered into the Newman Center and eventually become Catholic. This is amazing but not surprising. Before his time at UNLV, Fr. Daniel was in campus ministry at Arizona State University, University of Arizona, University of Oregon and Utah and Stanford. Thus, 28 years of his 31 as a priest are in campus ministry.

In fact, Fr. Daniel was born and raised in Arizona with three brothers, one of his brothers is now a priest of this Archdiocese. Fr. Daniel also has a ministry within the Dominicans called Spiritual Magic. Simply put, Fr. Daniel uses magic to create wonder about our Catholic Faith. I've seen him illustrate God's mercy with an empty jar that keeps replenishing with water somehow and teach about forgiveness with knot tricks.

It was one of my joys to co-sponsor Fr. Daniel into the Order with Dr. Elizabeth Fildes in 2022. He has been a great friend to me, and I am sure he will bring the magic of God's loving heart into your lives as well.



OUR DISCERNMENT STORY.... DEBBY AND DAVE BARTON







We've finished reading "Helena" a novel that Evelyn Waugh considered to be his favorite, and most ambitious, work--deftly traverses the forces of corruption, treachery, enlightenment, and political intrigue of Imperial Rome as it brings to life an inspiring heroine. In our discussions we learned that Waugh was primally a Satirist. That didn't help his only novel. None of us became a fan of this book.


So on to our next book "Don Quixote" by Miguel de Cervantes. Originally published in two parts, in 1605 and 1615, and considered to be one of the best-selling books of all times. With its experimental form and literary playfulness, Don Quixote has been generally recognized as the first modern novel. Don Quixote in the company of his faithful squire, Sancho Panza, travel the world and their exploits blossom in all sorts of wonderful ways. While Quixote's fancy often leads him astray—he tilts at windmills, imagining them to be giants—Sancho acquires cunning and a certain sagacity. Sane madman and wise fool, they roam together-and together they have haunted readers' imaginations for nearly four hundred years.

Our readings and discussions have been a complete joy. None of us 'EOHSJ Book Club members' are literary giants ... we've learned that great literature makes you think, which leads to stimulating discussion. And we must add ... great fellowship and friendship.
